Important information

What is the fund medical gap benefit?

The fund medical gap benefit is the difference between the Medicare rebate and the Medicare Schedule fee that your health fund will pay for in-hospital services.

Ancillary claims (such as dental and physiotherapy)

Ancillary claims, including dental, optical and physiotherapy, do not attract a Medicare benefit. However, as part of the Medicare two-way service, you are able to complete a Medicare two-way form, attach the original accounts/receipts and lodge your ancillary claim at a Medicare office. Your claim will be forwarded to your private health fund for payment.

Medicare two-way information

What is Medicare two-way?

Medicare two-way is an Australian Government initiative designed to make lodging health claims easier for people with private health insurance. Under Medicare two-way you can lodge all your in-hospital and ancillary claims either with your participating private health fund or with Medicare.

There are over 50 funds participating in Medicare two-way. A complete list is available on the Medicare Australia website at www.medicareaustralia.gov.au (click on Your Health). You can also ask at your local Medicare office.

How to lodge your Medicare two-way claim at a Medicare office

- complete a Medicare claim form and a Medicare two-way claim form—available at Medicare offices or on the Medicare Australia website at www.medicareaustralia.gov.au
- attach your original accounts and receipts if paid
- put the completed forms and attachments in the 'drop box'
- lodge with Medicare staff
- or post your claim to Medicare GPO Box 9822 in your capital city.

Medicare will pay your Medicare claim and forward your private health fund claim to your fund for processing. Private health fund payments will be paid by either electronic funds transfer (EFT) or cheque. You will need to check with your private health fund if they offer EFT facilities.

How to lodge your Medicare two-way claim at a private health fund

- complete your private health fund's claim form
- complete a Medicare claim form (available from your private health fund)
- attach your original accounts, and receipts if paid
- lodge the forms with the private health fund staff.
